The Better Governance Project (TBGP) is a newly started non-profit organisation with a focus on strengthening governance in low- and middle-income countries. Established at the close of 2020, we will be moving into new offices in January next year and are now looking to expand our team by recruiting an intern for the Spring term. Our ideal colleague is a self-starting, creative and solutions-orientated individual who would thrive in a start-up environment.

### About the organisation

Our organisation was founded on a belief that stronger institutions are the only long-term, sustainable path to improving the quality of life of citizens. Based in Stockholm, we work with government reformers and international donors on assignments aimed at improving governance in low and middle-income countries. Concretely, this means assisting public sector reformers to make change happen in hard-to-reform places; assisting civil society to advocate for better government; and helping donors to understand and navigate governance reform.

### The internship

We're a young team who started the organisation, and we're committed to keeping all the dynamism, creativity and innovativeness that comes with working with a start-up. For the internship, this means you'll have the opportunity to take on more responsibility than you might have at more established organisations. For the right candidate, and with support, this could in practice mean working on projects alongside civil servants to tackle public problems, leading the development of project proposals, conducting research and analysis, or assisting donors to design better programmes.

You should thrive in a constantly evolving working environment, enjoy finding creative solutions to difficult problems, and be able to work independently. The internship is of course a two-way process – and we're also interested to hear from prospective candidates about what inspires them and how the internship can align with the things that they're passionate about.
